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Mind-to-Mind Connections & Remote Viewing

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In ancient lore, it is said, that God, His Word (Torah) and His people are all connected. It is said that all of God's people are likewise connected. The original Hebrew word used to describe this connection is "aruvin," and actually means intertwined. The secret underlying any connection is the unseen and unfelt intertwining that unites us. Although we see ourselves as separate entities and each of us distinct from the world around us. This is merely the appearance of things, and is more of an illusion than a reality.

In the reality of things, any one thing is always in a state of connection with all other things. Some connections are stronger, while other connections are weaker. This state of connection to the Source creates the reality of what is today being called quantum entanglement.

Sentient consciousness should never be confused with human conscious intellectual thought. This mental process is merely the recognition of, and interaction with, the outer world, and has nothing to do with actual sentient consciousness. This is why intellectual thought can never expand into extra-sensory perceptions. This is because the intellect alone deals only with the sensory and not the extra-sensory. There are other parts of the mind that deal with the extra-sensory, and through these each individual can communicate with their counterparts in any other individual, be that individual human or not.

Such a child, however young can be inspired by nature, or even art in a museum, and can show promising talent and creativity that leads them to develop talents that lead to great creations. Such a creative child is not limited by rationality, logic and what makes sense. On the contrary, this child soars on the wings of imagination and dreams. These enable the child to fly into the mental spheres that no rational, logically mind person can follow.

Learn from children what is natural. Reacquire the child-like innocence and imagination that we each had as children, before it was pushed out of our minds by the constant drumming of being told to be rational, logical and to make sense.
