

Extraterrestrial Man, Israel & Torah

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Intro. *Every year at Shavuot, I perform traditional “yeridah” meditations (travels). My travels, and my guides, never seem to fail me. What I see, and what I am told, I often keep private, as I am instructed. Yet, this year, what I saw also came with instructions to reveal, but not to press dissemination with any real efforts. I got the impression that the following information is meant for those for whom it is meant. As for the rest, well, what about them?*

There is Torah. There is Man. There is Israel. There is Torah, Man and Israel here on Earth, and there are multiple (and possibly an infinite number of) manifestations of Torah, man and Israel spread throughout the universe, and in parallel dimensions.

Torah, Man and Israel are all expressions of what is called in the later Kabbalah, the “Small Face of God,” Zeir Anpin. Zeir Anpin (ZA) is a cosmic reality throughout the entire universe. It exists everywhere. Therefore, we must conclude that no matter where we go in space or in parallel dimensions, there will always be there an expression of Torah, Man and Israel for they are ZA.
