Healing "Demons" in Exorcisms

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Yes, I do exorcisms, real ones! Sometimes they can be real shows of the bizarre and supernatural, but most times they are just acts of loving kindness and healing.

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Many who think that they are possessed are only possessed within their own imaginations. Some are undiagnosed psychiatric cases that need to be under the care of a competent medical professional. Very few are actually struggling with an unwanted, and often uninvited earthbound soul that has somehow found refuge within the mind and body of an unsuspecting host. While this is rare, it does, nevertheless, happen.

When an actual possession does happen, it needs to be addressed properly and professionally, with care and compassion, by someone who has both knowledge and experience in these matters. Sorry, but just reading books and stories about these things does not provide one with enough information to handle the actual situations with proper professional proficiency.

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One must first understand the nature of exactly what is a possession. First, possessions have nothing to do with daemons. (In the title of this essay, I use the word "demon" merely for effect, and not to precisely identify the entities under discussion). Daemons do not possess human bodies. Daemons are a different type of life form. They live their lives as God created them to be.

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We are commanded to distance ourselves from them because daemons are "energyeaters." They do not eat physical foot-stuff because they are not physical beings. They do eat what we call "life-force" energy (nefesh, orgone, chi). If they discover a human being whose life-force energy "bleeds" from them due to whatever behaviors that cause this, in their eyes, this is a free meal. They will attach themselves to the individual to siphon off his energy, but they do not enter the person or take control of his mind or body.

Removing these "psychic-leeches" is not as hard as one might think. All one has to do to seal up the places where life-force energy is hemorrhaging. With these sealed, the siphoning ceases. One can read my book, Protection From Evil, and learn from there all one needs to know about how to seal off life-force energy hemorrhaging.

A possession occurs when a desperate earthbound soul wiggles its way into the mind and body of another, wherein which it does not belong. Before we discuss how such a soul is removed, let us first understand how it originally got into this sad and painful position.

When a soul leaves its body to travel to its next destination, what often appears before it is some kind of tunnel of light. The soul feels something like a vacuum sucking it down the tunnel towards the light. Once the soul is on the other side, it then proceeds to experience what it needs to experience, be it what we call Gehinom or Gan Eden (or anything else in between).

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There are, however, some souls that are so attached to their bodies, and their previous lives in this world, that they resist, with great efforts, the pull of the tunnel of light. Some actually run from it in panic and fear. Most souls are not strong enough to resist the vacuum of the tunnel, but the most desperate soul can and do resist. When these desperate souls panic and flee, the pull of the tunnel remains constant, but only for a short period. After this period, the vacuum subsides, the pull ceases, and the soul remains here on Earth, trapped, without body, without form, and also without a future or purpose. This state of loss and confusion only makes the soul more desperate. In its desperation it begins to wander.

Once a soul becomes earthbound, its absence in its expected place is noticed. When such a soul fails to show up, Watchers are dispatched in search of it. When they find it and catch it, reports document that they are anything but kind and gentle. The records say that they hound and pursue the earthbound soul and drag it to its assigned location. Needless to say, once an earthbound soul realizes that it is being pursued it flees with even greater panic than it had before.

In the mind of the earthbound soul, it is being pursued by evil demons, but in reality, the soul is being pursued by rather harsh Watchers (angels), whose job it is to corral souls in a fashion similar to how we here on Earth might corral animals. The Watchers act in this fashion to protect the souls from falling victim to the daemons.

Earthbound souls do not experience the world anymore as do we still in the flesh. In their new energy-body forms, they see things that no human eye sees, and they become subject to other natural laws and forces, that while in a human body, their bodies serves to protect them from. In daemonic eyes, earthbound souls are nothing more than a rich source of free food. Becoming aware of this danger, earthbound souls, already panicked, fearful and lost, seek refuge from those that are tracking them down. In greater desperation, they seek out human hosts similar to who they were while still in physical bodies. It is this law of likeattraction that defines how identification and movement occurs in this energetic domain. When such a prime candidate is sensed, discovered and found, then the earthbound soul zips through space (and time) to that living soul's side and seeks any and all methods to find an opening to slither inside its body and mind.

Understand this vital principle, in the domains of what is referred to as the spiritual, astral or energetic, attractions of like-kinds is similar to a magnetic pull. In other words, what an individual thinks and feels emanates from him in the form of waves (brain waves and other types). These waves emanate out into the ethers. Waves of a similar frequency, coming from similar thoughts and similar feelings from others are attracted to one another and congeal. One who thinks and feels a certain way attracts to oneself all these similar energies, be they good or evil.

Good forces reinforce an individual's good, evil forces reinforce an individual's evil. Earthbound souls can actually see these energy forces, and tap into them with ease, allowing the sympathetic magnetic energy to draw them towards those similar to how they

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lived when in the flesh. Once they are drawn to sympathetic souls all they need is an opportunity to sneak into the mind/soul through whatever opening a weak mind may provide. In Hebrew, these earthbound souls become dybbuks, which means, "clingers."

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Openings through which dybbuks enter come in many different ways. Whenever the mind is inebriated or when behavior is compromised, these create psychic opportunities for a magnetic draw from a like-minded soul. Earthbound souls brought close in such a way can enter the human body in exactly the same way as does a soul in the womb or later ibburim (incarnate helpers). I am not sure that anyone actually understands the details of exactly how this happens. Yet, it does happen, and much more often than one may think.

Once securely "inside," the earthbound soul (dybbuk), more than not, tries to keep its presence a secret and only subtly seeks to encourage specific behaviors within the individual, behaviors that the possessing soul itself wishes to again experience now that it has another body to inhabit.

If and when the invading earthbound soul is particularly evil, then it cares very little for the host, other than what can be wrung out of it. These souls make no such special efforts to conceal their presence. These are the ones that often create multiple personalities within the host, and often torment him, and compel him to perform disgusting things, all for the entertainment of the invading earthbound dybbuk soul.

First and foremost to performing any real exorcism, it must be ascertained that a real foreign psychic entity is present, and that we are not just dealing with a psychiatric condition or mental illness. There are distinct tests and ways to distinguish between the two. Unless all the criteria of proof can be met to validate the presence of a foreign psychic entity, the exorcist would be working in vain to assist in the healing an invading earthbound soul. For if no real soul is there, then no real exorcism and rectification can be performed. Therefore, it is imperative that all the proper tests be administered and passed in order to verify a bonafide foreign presence. The details of these tests are best left in the hands of the professional who understands rightly and properly how to administered them and to interpret their results.

Once an actual earthbound soul has been verified to be an unwelcome psychic invader, then proper steps are taken to assist it in not only leaving its present host, but also to agree to go along quietly with the Watchers to its assigned next phase. This can be a long drawn-out process, and certainly does not consist of threats or curses.

Earthbound souls recognize that, for the most part, threats and curses, and all the invocations and proclamations used in the name of this or that religion, add up to a big-fat zero! In other words, they are all, for the most part, ineffectual. Indeed, if we are dealing with a more malevolent soul, it may mock and scorn any religious acts used to exorcise it, thus proving their bankruptcy.

The only way to work with an earthbound soul is to begin its healing process. This is what we call in Hebrew, tikkun. This alone is the answer and the path of a proper exorcism. And depending on the individual earthbound soul, this process can be a very long and arduous one.

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
