Mazal Heshvan - The Trinity in Scorpio

Scorpio is three in one. It is the Scorpion, Eagle and Phoenix; no other sign of the Zodiac contains so much power. Yet, with such great power also comes great responsibility.

The scorpion must learn to spread its wings and to fly like the Eagle, one of the four faces of the Merkava.

Once it soars above, it can see clearly from the heights what it could not see before. Only when the scorpion has taken flight as the Eagle can it ever expect to transform into the Phoenix.



Only the Phoenix touches Heaven and thus brings G-d's Presence down to Earth. For this reason was the Temple consecrated during this month. The Scorpio/Phoenix is the force that bonds with the Shekhina.
