### **167 forever!**

While we have discussed the dangers facing human beings from non-human entities and from earthbound human souls, we must now discuss one of the most powerful occult dangers in the hands of our fellow living human beings. While occult practitioners use all types of secret rituals to solicit their goals, regular everyday people commonly use a powerful occult tool without even realizing that they are wielding it. Everyday people using this occult tool of pernicious evil cause more harm to more individuals than all the occult adepts combined. The tool of evil that we must explore and understand is the common everyday usage of the Ayin HaRa, the evil eye.

The evil eye does not really have to do anything with the physical eye itself, although the physical eye may be used as its tool. The power of the evil eye rises from within the imagination. It can be projected upon its object, from a distance in both space and time. The evil eye is the force of negativity that comes forth from the unconscious mind.

The force of malevolence projects itself upon the conceived image in the mind. Through the mind the malevolent thought is projected onto the unaware victim. Again, I emphasize that this is done daily by almost everyone onto almost everyone. It is done unconsciously and often unknowingly to both perpetrator and victim. Yet, regardless of the lack of conscious awareness the attack is still perpetuated and the harm most definitely done.

So prevalent and dangerous is the evil eye that our Sages have said that the evil eye is the prime cause of death, more than anything else. While one might succumb to accident or illness, the openings in one's soul that let these in were pried open by the evil eye that first struck the person.

At the level of the unconscious, all human minds are connected. As such communication at the unconscious level from mind to mind is an ongoing process. We are always bombarded with the thoughts and impressions of others, be they from far or up close. What others think about us can affect us even if we do not know them or have never met them. All they have to do is think about us, or the image of one of us, seen anywhere, in any photo, still or

video and instantaneously their projected thoughts are magnetically transferred through the dimension of mind directly to the object of their mental conceptions.

This mental process, we have discussed previously. This process of thought transference is the underlying foundation of all ESP. It is also the system how we transfer blessings and prayers; and of course, how we also transfer curses and the evil eye.

There really is not much of a difference between a curse and the evil eye. The major difference is that a curse is usually placed with awareness, words and some symbolic form of ceremony. The evil eye has the same affect as a formal curse, but without all the pomp and ceremony. Again, it is often transferred unconsciously, unbeknownst to both the one placing it and the one receiving it.

The evil eye can cause one all sorts of misfortune both in the immediate present and last far into the future. It can block and hinder one from having success in almost any of life's endeavors. The evil eye is like a malignant cancer. It must be removed with surgical accuracy in order for one to be cured and become well.

Usually one cannot in any way feel the placement of the evil eye. It does not strike with a bang. Its placement does hit one hard, but its presence is only detectable by what it causes. Therefore, by the time its malevolent power finds its first manifestation it might have already been there for a long time. Therefore, it is almost impossible to ascertain where the evil eye came from.

This is especially true to anyone in the public eye, whose picture or image is prominently displayed. Once such an individual irks others, there will be an avalanche of evil eye upon them. This is why so many politicians and entertainment industry individuals suffer from so many personal problems, in their health, physical and mental and other areas of their lives. It is all due to the evil eye, projected onto them however unknowingly by countless numbers of malevolent wishes from the dark side of even otherwise good hearts. Mind you again, it is not only the rich and famous who suffer from this, but everyone.

There are two specific issues we must address. First we must learn what one can do to protect oneself from becoming an unknowing victim of the evil eye. Second, we can discuss ways to remove the evil eye upon one so infected.

To protect oneself from the evil eye is actually not a hard thing for the most part. Occult adepts and holy sages alike are masters at avoiding the evil eye by the most simplest of methods. Remember what the evil eye is and how it is attracted. Remembering these one can easily take the necessary steps to avoid

it, if one is appropriately wise and disciplined enough to do what needs to be done.

The evil eye is attracted upon a person through that which one is most proud of. What one shows off to the world is the primary target that arouses jealousy and the evil eye. Let me give you a clear example.

Many years ago I was walking down a New York City street with a female associate. A very attractive woman passed by us walking in the opposite direction. Being single at the time and like most males of the species possessing a yetzer hara (evil inclination), her attractiveness caught my eye and I watched her as she passed to our left. Yet, as she passed I noticed something more stunning than the woman herself. I noticed that my female associate was staring at this woman, much more intently than I ever thought to. I understand when a man notices a woman, but why would one woman gaze at another? Then as the woman passed, my associate mumbled under her breath, "bitch," turned around and then we proceeded on our way as if nothing happened.

I was rather shocked by this response and turned to ask my associate, "Do you know this woman?" She replied that she never met her. Then I asked her in shock, why then would she call her such a horrible name. She looked at me and asked if I noticed how "put together" she appeared; such good make-up, accessories and poise. My associate said she makes other women, like herself, look bad in comparison. No sooner had she said these words that we heard a commotion behind us. Apparently someone was not looking when they were about to cross the street and walked right into a stopped bus. Like everyone else I paused to look. To my surprise, it was the attractive woman who just passed us by.

My associate, a supposedly G-d fearing religious woman, however unknowingly placed the evil eye on this woman because of how "put together" she was. It had an almost immediate affect in that for whatever reason she alone of over a dozen people on that street corner did not see a rather large city bus and walked right into it. I did not stay to offer any medical assistance, there were plenty others to provide it. We continued to walk along and I learned a great lesson how the evil eye works in such overt form, in such a quick fashion and with such devastating consequences.

I do not believe that the attractive woman desired to attract the evil eye, but it was clear from her very attractive appearance that she did desire to attract attention, and that is exactly what she received, even though the attention was not the kind she solicited. This is a classic example of the evil eye and we can learn from this many things.

The evil eye is attracted to all those things that can be seen to the naked eye and are meant to be attractive. This includes one's appearance and one's possessions. These more than anything else can cause one serious harm. Now, looking good and having nice things, in and of themselves are not bad, however flaunting them is sure to attract unwanted and dangerous attention. The only way one protects oneself from such unwanted attention is to guard oneself by hiding from the eyes of others that which they have no business to see. This is the underlying reason for modesty in both behavior and dress.

The magnetic law of attraction always works in both ways. It attracts what you want and what you do not want. No one can be immune from this, no matter how righteous or holy one is. Even one's righteousness or holiness, if prominently displayed can become a target for the evil eye. Many a public holy or righteous figure has suffered from numerous illnesses and mishaps all due to the evil eye.

One may rightly ask how come G-d does not protect His own from such evil occurrences. The answer is that G-d does indeed protect His own, but not by some magical power force, but rather by practical intelligent steps taken by the servants of Heaven themselves.

In ancient literature we are taught that the evil eye can only rest upon that which the physical eye can see. Hide something from sight and it is naturally protected. Pay attention here! There is always great wisdom in the act of concealment. One must be wise and learn how to conceal one's wealth, one's strengths and yes, even one's wisdom, all the more so, one's physical attractiveness. The simple act of concealment, keeping something under wraps, or under non-revealing clothing is the best protection against the evil eye and many other occultic devices.

There is an old saying, "loose lips sink ships." If you desire to keep something safe from attack, physical or psychic, you simply do not talk about it, AT ALL, to anyone, at any time, for any reason, period! This is always a great policy to follow throughout life. One should never discuss any aspect about one's private life. Our society today hemorrhages with information everywhere. There no longer exists the age-old concept of privacy. Idle chatter today is the norm where people gossip about the most intimate details about their lives and the private matters in the lives of others around them. How many people gossip about their mates sleeping or eating habits, how he or she is this way or that, for good or for bad? All this type of apparently idle chatter is cannon fodder for placing the evil eye. It causes so much damage that I cannot begin to relate it all.

Let me provide an example that I saw first hand. Many years ago I was approached independently by two married couples seeking help to overcome problems with adultery. A member of one couple got involved with a member

of the other couple and things got more messy from there. One couple was newlyweds, married literally for just a few weeks. The other couple was married for years with children. Both couples were supposedly religious. The key between both couples was that the wives were life long friends, who shared all their secrets with one another. This is where "loose lips sink ships." Some secrets are not meant to be shared, especially amongst close-knit girl friends.

Soon after the marriage of the one couple, the two wives got together to discuss amongst other things, the one's honeymoon. The newlywed wife ranted and bragged about the sexual prowess of her new husband and related in graphic detail of how he pleased her and brought her to the point of ecstasy. Without even realizing it, she set up her husband for a psychic attack.

After a few days, the unsuspecting newlywed husband was invited over to the house of his wife's best friend to supposedly help her with something that her own husband did not have time to address. Needless to say, this was a ruse. The newlywed husband was meet by his wife's closest girlfriend who related back to him all the sordid details of his honeymoon and then said that his own wife wanted to share her joy with her girlfriend, but that in the decorum of the religious community in which they lived (not Jewish) it had to be done in this secret way. Knowing his newlywed wife truly did share everything with her life-long girlfriend, and probably not being too resistant, acquiesced and gave the married woman an adulterous experience to remember.

The newlywed husband did not share this with his wife, nor did the married woman share this with her husband. Yet, when the two women got together again, "loose lips did sink ships." When the newlywed wife continued to brag, the married woman let slip two words. She simply said, "I know." Immediately, without having to say more the newlywed wife understood what had happened. She was furious; she felt betrayed and very much wanted revenge. Mind you, she was not angry with her best friend. She was angry with her husband. She was not a bit angry at her friend. She was angry that her husband kept this a secret from her.

Matters went from bad to worse, with both women now acting in ways with both husbands that need no explanation. Two pregnancies resulted. At the time of my involvement, the identities of both fathers were in question. The couples wanted to stay together and bury the past, but the husbands were having a hard time with this, whereas the two life-long friends wanted to put this all behind them. I was not involved in the resolution of this mess, but I have since come to realize that this type of behavior is certainly far from an isolated event.

When circumstances like this arise, the souls emanating into such children are derived from nefarious sources. This is how Shedim and earth-bound souls find human hosts in which to incarnate.

The evil eye is not only passed on through what one sees, it is equally passed on through what one speaks. The evil eye is intimately connected with what we call evil speech (Lashon HaRa). Now, evil speech does not have to have malevolent intent. Any revelation of any information can be evil speech if it can be in any way used or abused to create a harmful outcome, as in the case above.

Not for naught has the military and intelligence community developed a term describing some information as being passed on only on a "need to know" basis. This is a tremendous idea that everyone should adopt in their own personal lives. No information, however apparently unimportant or irrelevant should be shared with anyone for any reason. Remember, loose lips sink ships and you never know how your most innocent intentions can be twisted and turned against you.

Malevolent intent is often fired up by jealousy. Jealousy is not always malicious in intent, however it often turns malicious when one is willing to harm another just to get what one wants. Often one does not just want what the other has; one wants to have it and for the other not to have it. Thus jealousy also breeds selfishness. All these attributes are powerful magnetic attractors that draw Shedim and earth-bound souls to cling to one, thus creating and causing more harm.

Protecting oneself from the evil eye does not require occultic rituals. Rather, protection against the evil eye requires good common sense, strong moral values, and the ability to keep one's big mouth shut and for one to learn how to be private, even when completely, openly exposed. Being private in public is not as hard as it may sound. It simply requires one of the most praised religious traits. One must cultivate humility and make every effort not to do anything that will be exceptionally noticed by anyone.

Invisibility is the key. Anonymity is the key. Simplicity is the key. None of this means that one must be mediocre. On the contrary one must become greatly exceptional. However, one's greatness must never be publicly exposed. One must not advertise one's prized possessions, be they physical, psychic or spiritual.

The greatest and most powerful of spiritual/psychic beings are the most simple and non-descript individuals. Occult masters know this truth very well. Real occult masters always seem to be regular everyday people. Those who dress up in pomp and ceremony are usually the charlatans and imposters. This is also true with Rabbis and Kabbalists. The real powerful ones will pass you by on the

street and you will never notice them. They know how to blend in. Even when you know who they are, they will always appear simple. True masters never embrace pomp and grandeur. Their might is in their actions and their actions are concealed from all prying eyes.

Living in simplicity, dressing modestly, speaking softly and acting normally are great tools to deflect the evil eye and evil speech. The desire to be noticed and to stand out is one's worst enemy. Blending in, looking like everyone else and not advertising yourself is a safe course for all to follow. Targets stand out. That which is not noticeable is next to invisible. That which is invisible does not get noticed and therefore is never targeted to be hit. This common sense is one of the greatest secrets of the occult. It is also one of the essential requirements for holiness.

Religious law has always dictated to us to guard what we say and to guard our eyes from gazing at dangerous images. The mind can only desire that which the eye has seen. The Ten Commandments themselves warn us against forbidden desires, also known as coveting. Coveting makes you crave that which another has. Such unfulfilled desires lead to the evil eye. This happens automatically and unconsciously. It cannot be avoided. As long as one's heart is impure so will be one's thoughts and desires. Knowing well the frailty of the human heart, religious laws were instituted to protect us from ourselves.

Modest dress for both men and women save us from unwanted and unwelcome glaring stares. This is especially necessary for our children. Those who allow their children to dress like Hollywood whores place these kids in serious harm's way. I would go so far to call such permissiveness child abuse. Parents, guard your children; watch how they dress. Keep it simple and modest. Parents, watch your own behaviors. Your children will learn from you, not from what you say, but rather from what you do. If they observe that you place the evil eye upon others, they will learn from you to do the same. You will therefore become a partner in their crimes.

Even if you are very wealthy, this does not mean you have to flaunt your wealth with ridiculous superfluous spending. This is a sure way to draw the evil eye upon yourself. If you are attractive, you do not have to flaunt it to the world. Your attractiveness should be your special gift to your spouse and no other. Your spouse is your protection, not your source of harm. If you are wise or educationally gifted, do not flaunt your knowledge to the world. Academic jealousy strongly arouses the evil eye, especially in religious circles. This is why certain Sages grossly disrespect other Sages.

All these behaviors are outright evil in and of themselves. Worse than their being evil, they are also magnets to attract sinister Shedim and earthbound souls. Ultimately a bad heart leads to bad behavior. Bad behavior leads to terrible outcomes. Terrible outcomes bring harm to many far and wide. This is

how evil propagates. One is therefore either part of the problem or part of the cure.

Occult mechanics operate based upon the realities of human nature. The more we understand about ourselves, the better we will understand the realities of our world and the true nature of the evil within it and within ourselves. More than Shedim and earthbound souls the greatest dangers we face come from ourselves. Occult masters know this well and manipulate our own weaknesses to their advantage.

Do not fear the occult, those who master it or those entities that they can invoke. Rather be afraid of your own weaknesses and safeguard yourself against them by changing your behavior and your attitudes. I cannot over emphasize or repeat this point enough.
