There are not and will not be definitive physical safe havens for people to run to in times of crises. This was a lesson learned well by those who fled from the German Nazis in WWII. Yet, by no means does this say that there are no safe havens at all. By all means, safe havens, there are! But, you must understand first what a safe haven is supposed to be. Then, you must grasp how to get to the authentic safe havens. And, access to them is not through any physical door or passageway.
